The Building Act 1993 requires most people who carry out building work or are in the business of building, to be registered as building practitioners with the Building Practitioners Board. To provide consumers with better protection, registered Building Practitioners are generally required to carry the appropriate insurance. The Building Practitioners Board registers individuals not companies or businesses. The ability to be registered is based upon the nature and extent of qualifications and experience in the following categories:

and classes of building practitioners are currently required to be registered with the Building Practitioners Board: Building surveyor, Building inspector (Unlimited / Limited), Quantity surveyor, Engineer (Civil / Mechanical / Electrical / Fire Safety), Draftsperson (Building design- architectural, interior, services), Builder (Commercial builder - unlimited / limited), Builder (Domestic builder - unlimited / limited / manager), Builder (Demolisher - low rise buildings / medium rise buildings / unlimited), Erector or supervisor (Temporary structures - Class 1 and 2).
